Employment Income Estimator: regular employment

How much money will you take home starting October 1?

The estimated take-home amount will change when you move the 2 sliders. If you can't use this estimator, contact your Caseworker or Care Coordinator for help.

Income Assistance cheque amount (without wages)

Move the slider to the number closest to your Income Assistance cheque amount (not counting any reductions from wages.)

Monthly wages from working

Move the slider to the number closest to what you earn from working after taxes and deductions.



Estimated take-home amount

This is an estimate of how much money you'll take home each month. It includes your wages from work and your Income Assistance cheque (after we calculate the reduction.)

\$1187.5

Based on your income assistance cheque amount and your monthly wages, your estimated cheque reduction will be \$487.50. Your old income assistance cheque reduction would have been around \$525.00.


