Selection Process

All submitted proposals will be reviewed and selected according to the following criteria (in no specific order of importance):

- Clarity and accuracy
- Geographical representation

- Originality and creativity
- Context within current practices/climate

Note: OMSSA may receive multiple proposals reflecting the same / similar themes and content. In these cases, we will work with interested parties to collaborate or partner on a single workshop.

SESSION FORMATS

OMSSA is interested in exploring opportunities for both plenary / keynote sessions and breakout sessions:

- Plenary / keynote sessions are typically 30 minutes to 1 hour in length, and delivered in a large room to an audience of 250+ delegates
- **Breakout sessions** are typically 90 minutes in length, and delivered in medium sized rooms to an audience of between 30 and 100 delegates

OMSSA will assess proposals for suitability for either plenary or breakout sessions. In some cases, we may look to work with interested parties to combine session content and collaborate on a joint plenary or breakout session on similar themes or topics.
